Plum Pockets. This is a fungal disease that affects plum trees. The disease is usually caused by the fungus Taphrina communis, and sometimes by the fungus Taphrina pruni. Infection occurs shortly after blossoms open, but is not evident on fruits until they are 6-12 mm in diameter.
