Classical Antiquity (or Ancient Greece and Rome) is a period of about 900 years, when ancient Greece and then ancient Rome (first as a Republic and then as an Empire) dominated the Mediterranean area, from about 500 B.C.E. - 400 C.E. Collectively, many people consider these cultures the beginning of Western Civilization and the basis for many of the ideals of Western Europe and later the United States.
