Originally trophies were related to war. In fact, the word has a Greek background and comes from "tropaion" which loosely translates to "a structure which represents the defeat of an enemy". Interestingly, in ancient times the Olympian winners weren't actually awarded with trophies or medals, instead they received a laurel wreath.
